Curriculum Description

The program is characterized by the process of 1) pursuing aesthetics concerns, 2) using visual and supplementary sensory devises creatively to translate ideas and 3) producing and authoring media and related technologies to express ideas, communicate message, and raise opinions to elicit reactions and action from audiences, users, or receivers of information.

Program Educational Objectives of Fine Arts major in Visual Communication
